

The scope of this project included program and project management, as well as technical support, for Air Combat Command Headquarters (HQ ACC) and at specific Air Force installations. ACC modified the Task Order twice to increase the scope of activities.

- HQ ACC Tasks: Project required a management level review and analysis of the status of more than 750 remediation sites across the 16 Air Force installations under ACC. The review included an assessment of current status of all sites within the Restoration Program as well as an assessment of current Remediation, RAO, and LTM activities at all open sites. After review, LRS Federal made recommendations for optimization and cost savings at the RAO and LTM sites reviewed.



- Installation specific Tasks:

1. Renewal of Minot AFB's RCRA Part B Permit to include two new restoration sites. The installation's RCRA Part B renewal permit received final approval by the North Dakota Department of Health (NDDH) in October 2008.
2. *Provided long-term groundwater monitoring and optimization services at Minot AFB in 2008 at sites LF-02 and SS-09.*
3. Completed the Minot AFB Area of Concern C – Building 510/511 Phase I Corrective Measures Implementation report which received final approval by NDDH in November 2009.
4. Completed the Minot AFB Area of Concern C – Building 510/511 Phase II Corrective Measures Implementation Report.

Provided program management support at Shaw AFB, South Carolina, to address significant technical, management, legal and public relations challenges resulting from off-site contamination issues affecting private properties. Activities included updating of the Community Relations Plan, presentations at Restoration Advisory Board meetings, facilitation of regulatory interaction, and implementation of bilateral agreements with public residents impacted by off-site contamination.
