

LRS Federal provided on-site support and management for the Buckley AFB stormwater program. Due to significant construction activities, a municipal separate storm sewer (MS4) permit, and other activities, significant requirements existed under this program to maintain a proactive compliance posture.

Work efforts performed under this contract included:

- Construction Stormwater Program Support – LRS Federal was tasked to support the construction program by developing Construction Permit Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plans for various construction projects across the base. Additionally, LRS performed on-going construction permit compliance assistance site visits to ensure on-going compliance. LRS provided technical support and consulting to assist construction contractors in developing and maintaining compliance requirements. LRS also performed construction permit compliance monitoring to ensure contractors complied with regulatory requirements of the stormwater program.
- Program Management Support – LRS supported the base program with general awareness and best management practice support. LRS was tasked to provide information to the Buckley AFB's Community Advisory Group on the overall program and on things the local community can do to prevent incidences. This also included development of educational material and best management practices (BMP) guidance.
- Municipal Stormwater Program Support - LRS was tasked to write the annual MS4 Permit Report as required by the installation's permit under EPA Region 8. This report documents the program's compliance posture over the previous year. Additionally this effort required LRS to update the installation's MS4 Stormwater Management Plan based on the findings from annual report.
- Industrial Stormwater Support – LRS Federal was required to conduct the annual Comprehensive Site Compliance Evaluation (CSCE) in accordance with the installation's Multi-Sector General Permit. This evaluation documents the status of current operations, and updated the permit with any new facilities that may impact overall compliance. LRS also updated the Industrial Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) as part of this effort.
- Stormwater Environmental Planning – LRS also assisted the overall program through early identification of issues that could impact the installation's compliance posture. This involved Work Order reviews, National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) related reviews (AF813s, EAs), and review of project plans & specifications.
